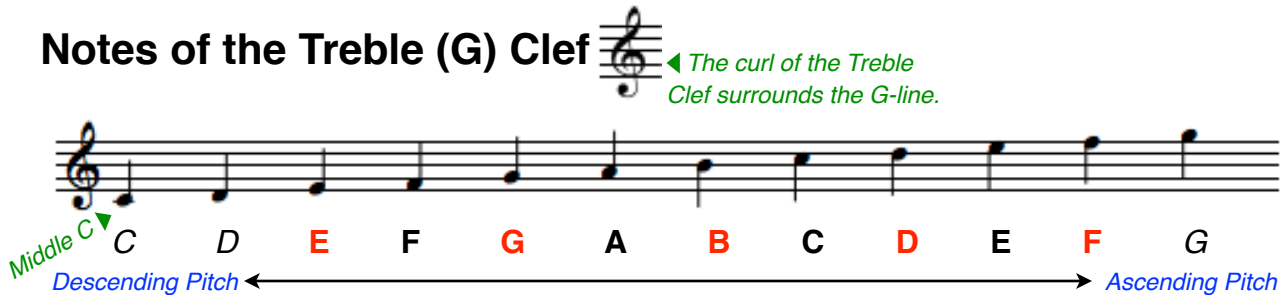


NOTES AND PITCHES

Just as there are many colours in the light spectrum, there are many pitches in the audio spectrum. In music, some pitches are labelled with note names using the letters of the alphabet, A through G. These letters keep repeating as you ascend or descend in pitch i.e. if you are ascending, the next letter after G is A again; if you are descending the next letter before A is G again.

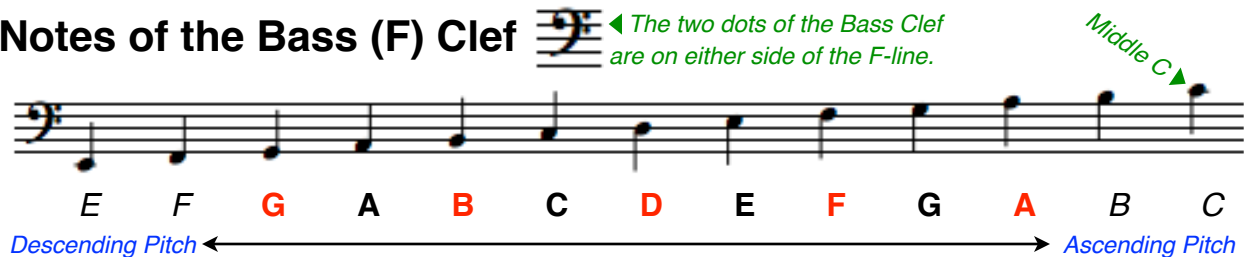
Notes of the Treble (G) Clef



To help you remember note names on the treble clef,

- ★ all the spaces from the bottom space spell FACE,
- ★ all the lines from the bottom, **E**very **G**ood **B**oy **D**eserves **F**udge

Notes of the Bass (F) Clef



To help you remember note names on the bass clef,

- ★ all the spaces from the bottom space read **A**ll **C**ows **E**at **G**rass,
- ★ all the lines from the bottom, **G**ood **B**oys **D**eserve **F**udge **A**lways
