Spirit's Call Choir is a Winnipeg offering of **Spirit's Call TM** - founded in 1996 by Merv Campone and Dorothy Becker to contribute to the transformation of consciousness and support personal and universal harmony and balance through the integration of healing, learning and the arts. Spirit's Call is based in Vancouver and Winnipeg.

The **Spirit's Call Collection** includes the book *Spirit's Call – When the Spirit Touches the Soul*, the relaxation tape *Spirit's Call – A Companion for Healing* and an original art card. These are on display and available for purchase in the foyer with both the choir's CD's.

About NEST

The North End Sponsorship Team (NEST) is a cooperative ministry of nine congregations, plus individual members who work in harmony to sponsor refugees into our midst. Since it began in 1986, NEST has welcomed 41 sponsorships to Winnipeg for a total of 147 persons from 18 countries: Afghanistan, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Burundi, Colombia, Democratic Republic of Congo, El Salvador, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Iran, Iraq, Kosovo, Myanmar (Burma), Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Togo, and Vietnam. Next year, 2011, will be NEST's 25th anniversary year.

NEST sponsorships are normally arranged through Canadian Lutheran World Relief, our "Sponsorship Agreement Holder" with the Canadian Department of Citizenship and Immigration. NEST also works in cooperation with Welcome Place and other groups involved in bringing refugees to Canada. Sponsorships are usually for a period of one year from the date of arrival in Canada, but may be for two years in special situations.

NEST has agreed to four more full sponsorships, one JAS (Joint Assistance) sponsorship (government supplies financial support, NEST provides caregiving) and six more family-linked sponsorships for a total of 39 more persons. Canada Immigration must approve these refugees for entry into Canada. Such approval can take three years or longer to obtain, and may be denied. We pray for their safe and early arrival in Winnipeg.

The world continues to produce refugees in need of our help. NEST is limited in the number of sponsorships it can take by the finances available and especially by the number of volunteers available for caregiving. NEST also very much needs storage space in order to accept donations of furniture and other household goods, as well as warm winter clothing.
