ABOUT SPIRIT'S CALL CHOIR

Spirit's Call Choir is a Winnipeg offering of Spirit's Call [™] - founded in Vancouver in 1996 by Merv Campone and Dorothy Becker to contribute to the transformation of consciousness and support personal and universal harmony and balance through the integration of healing, learning and the arts. Winnipeg's Spirit's Call Choir makes real the founding vision to raise money for development work through the creative arts.

Spirit's Call Choir is an inclusive, non-audition community choir that supports:

- personal harmony singing to bring balance and joy to our inner being
- choral harmony singing to create beautiful sound in our vocal community
- global harmony singing to support transformation, justice and peace

Through its Global Harmony initiatives, Spirit's Call Choir has raised over \$133,000 for worthy causes locally and globally and received the Mayor's Volunteer Service Award in 2010.

Since November 2003, Spirit's Call Choir has presented 2 benefit concerts a year. Today, the choir is delighted to partner with The Rotary Club of Winnipeg for this special 10th Anniversary benefit concert - to raise funds to support inner city youth. Special thanks to Pat Vallance for coordinating Rotary's participation and for her unwavering commitment to this project and this partnership.

Spirit's Call Choir grew out of an "Explorations of the Self" workshop with Dorothy Becker and Margaret Tobin in November 2000 when people who had been told and believed they couldn't sing found their voices and decided to form a choir. The first musical director, Lyle Eide, joined the choir in the fall of 2001. This Spirit-inspired singing experience continues to grow and thrive under the enthusiastic leadership of our Musical Director Jeremy Vallance. Previous directors Michael Kurek, and Alex Kirov also made significant contributions.

Spirit's Call Choir has released 2 CD's - *One World, One Voice* (2009) and *Together in Harmony* (2005). Choir CD's make it possible to bring the energy of this spirited singing into your homes and cars all through the year - and offer a way to give the gift of song for the holiday season. The CD's are available in the foyer at the special 10th Anniversary price of 2 for \$30 (Regularly \$20 each)

Spirit's Call Choir was founded on the principle that singing is the birthright of everyone. From 9 original members, Spirit's Call Choir has grown to 174 voices and includes novice to accomplished singers and musicians. The choir offers a supportive environment for remembering, reclaiming and celebrating the spirit and voice of one and all and welcomes all those who want to find their voice and sing for joy!

Spirit's Call Choir invites new members for the spring season — starting Sunday January 15, 2012. The orientation for new members is at 1:30 pm on January 15th. The full choir sings from 2:00 to 4:30pm January 15th and weekly (Sunday afternoons) at the Unitarian Church, 603 Wellington Crescent (at Maryland Academy).
