Previous directors **Michael Kurek**, and **Alex Kirov** also made significant contributions.

Spirit's Call Choir has released 2 CD's. Choir CD's make it possible to bring the energy of this spirited singing into your homes and cars all through the year–and are another way to give the gift of song for Mother's Day! **ONE**WORLD ONE VOICE was launched at the 7th annual benefit concert for NEST (North End Sponsorship Team) on November 28, 2009 – to support refugees from distant

lands and all who have had to leave their homes to seek safety and freedom. **ONE WORLD ONE VOICE** and the choir's first CD **Together in Harmony** (2005) are available for purchase here tonight
