Founding Vision

Spirit's Call Choir is a Winnipeg offering of Spirit's Call ™. Spirit's Call ™ was founded in Vancouver in 1996 by Merv Campone and Dorothy Becker to contribute to the transformation of consciousness and support personal and universal harmony and balance through the integration of healing, learning and the arts. Winnipeg's Spirit's Call Choir makes real the founding vision to raise funds for development work through the creative arts.

History of the Choir

Spirit's Call Choir started in an "Explorations of the Self" workshop with Margaret Tobin and Dorothy Becker in November 2000 when people who thought they couldn't sing found their voices and decided to form a choir.

The first Musical Director joined the choir in 2001. The choir has grown from 9 founding members to 160 voices. Spirit's Call Choir was founded on the principle that singing is the birthright of everyone. As well as welcoming uncertain singers, the choir now also includes novice to accomplished singers, dancers and musicians – all who love singing in community for the joy of it - and for causes beyond themselves.

Previous concerts have raised awareness and funds for development projects for organizations supporting refugee families settling in Winnipeg, women, children, youth and families in inner city neighbourhoods, those in urgent need of basic household items - and to promote justice, equality, harmony and peace in our world

Healthy Start for Mom & Me is an ideal fit for Spirit's Call Choir to be singing for here today. Both Healthy Start and Spirit's Call Choir embrace the new, the nervous, the risk takers. Sometimes just showing up can be an act of courage.

What is unique to the Healthy Start newcomers program is that women who do not yet speak English can come with their babes & toddlers and learn about how to have healthy babies and families in Canada - in their own language - through programs simultaneously interpreted in up to 20 different languages.

What is unique about Spirit's Call Choir's welcoming, inclusive, non-audition approach is that people who believed they could not sing can be supported to find their voices – in singing and in life. The magic of gaining confidence, whether it be singing in front of others or parenting Canadian style, happens because of peer support and gentle coaching.
